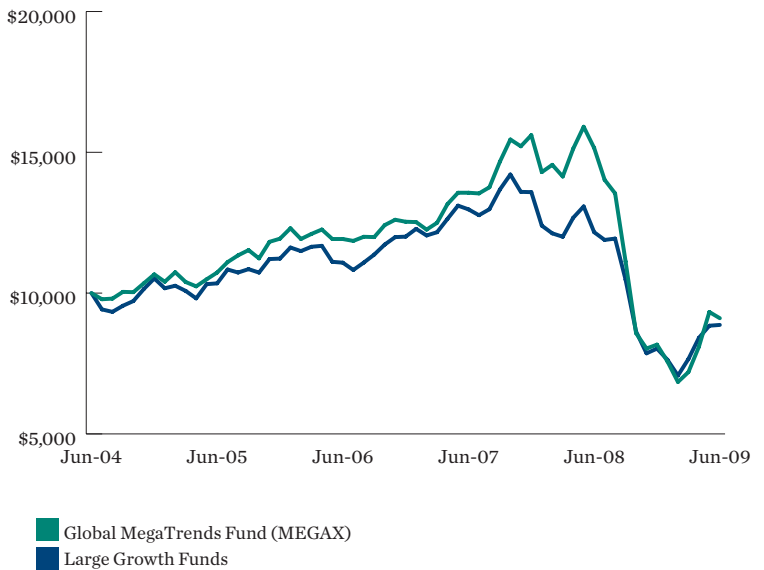

Fund Strategy

The Global MegaTrends Fund seeks to invest in companies that are positioned to grow by providing capital goods, basic materials, professional services or other key inputs to facilitate the design, construction, maintenance, financing, or servicing of global infrastructure properties.

In addition to the focus on investments in infrastructure, the fund seeks to invest in companies that meet suitable measures of return on cash flow, growth in revenue, earnings growth and return on equity. There is no constraint upon the markets that the fund management will consider.

¹The S&P 500 Stock Index is a widely recognized capitalization-weighted index of 500 common stock prices in U.S. companies. ²Portfolio holdings will change. ³Fund Assets can include, but are not limited to, equities, bonds, cash, receivables, pre-paid expenses and other miscellaneous assets.
